

Maths

All children will continue to strengthen their understanding of decimals – this will include decimals up to one whole. Year 6 will be learning more about algebra; they will be finding the rule within a sequence, forming expressions and equations, and learning about substitution and formulae. Art

After the finishing touches to our Egyptian Death Masks, the children will be exploring and creating abstract art inspired by Wassily Kandinsky. **What colours do you associate with different emotions?**

Music

Our focus song is 'The Fresh Prince of Bel-Air' - Will Smith, and we will develop our own rap song. **Try to start thinking about what issues in the world you would like to create a rap song about.**

PE

Our focus is on handball, planned by Mr Tanner, leading to the handball festival on 24th of March.

Geography

Until the end of this term, we will be learning about rivers. We will focus on their journey from start to finish and end the unit by looking at the impact that rising levels have on a wider global scale. ***Try taking a river walk and see what wildlife relies on the river; could you perhaps take and share any pictures with the class?***

Computing

We will be learning about spreadsheets and how to plot data. Planning an event will be our concluding task. ***What events would you like to plan? Where would you like to go?***

RE

'What did Jesus do to save humans?' is our topic question for this half-term. **Do you know any family members or friends that you could ask that follow Christianity?**

PSHE

Our theme this half-term is *Healthy Me*. **What information would you need to share to a call-handler if you dialled for an emergency service?**

Science

The children will show how reversible and irreversible changes occur based on our previous unit, which is completed through experiments. Then, the children will learn to describe the changes of humans as they develop through old age. **Ask an older relative or friend about how their body has changed through time. What can they now do that they couldn't? What do they wish they could still do?**

English

For the first half of this half term, we will be Looking at how persuasive writing is used for many different reasons and what techniques are used in doing this. This will lead to Spiders writing their own persuasive adverts for a product of their choice.

For the second half, using the Literacy Shed video 'The Black Hole', we will be using this as inspiration to write a narrative story. This will allow Spiders to really produce their own creative ideas for their writing.
